





Speaker and Deputy Speakers

One Speaker and two Deputy Speakers shall be elected for a two-year term by the Plenary session by secret ballot. The Speaker shall represent the Provincial Assembly, regulate its proceedings, and supervise its affairs. In the event the Speaker cannot carry out the duties of his or her office, the Deputy Speaker designated by the Speaker shall act for him or her.









Standing Committee

As a permanent body established to review various bills professionally and efficiently, it reviews them in advance before the plenary session, which ultimately decides the will of the parliament, and operates 7 standing committees for each specialized field. All members except the Speaker belong to each standing committee, and the term of office is two years.
















Special Committee


It is constituted by a vote at the plenary meeting when necessary to review and process a specific agenda and remains in effect until the agenda is decided at the plenary session. However, the Special Committee on Budget and Accounting and the Special Committee on Ethics are stipulated in the ordinance so that they can be operated at all times.



The members of the first Jeollanam-do Provincial Assembly were elected in May 1952 following the Local Autonomy Act enacted in 1949. The first assembly was opened created with 59 members and the second and the third assemblies followed up on this first assembly. Unfortunately, the Jeollanam-do Provincial Assembly suffered dissolution in on the May 16 military coup in 1961. Along with the establishment of the Local Government, the 4th Assembly opened following the a local election in June 1991. Since then, the Assembly has continued up to the current 12th one. The Jeollanam-do Provincial Assembly respects the decision-making process based on the citizens and the local community, and has formed an assembly in which the citizens are the main agent.

Assembly Operation

The Jeollanam-do Provincial Assembly consists of 1 speaker, 2 deputy speakers, 7 standing committees, special committees, and an assembly secretariat. The Assembly operations range from general meetings, standing committees, and special meetings. Assembly meetings are largely divided into two sessions: regular and special sessions. Each year, 130 days are allocated to assembly meetings, which also include regular and special sessions.

Regular sessions are held twice a year and consist of up to 60meeting days. The 1st regular session is held on the first Tuesday of every June and the 2nd regular session is held on the first Tuesday of every November. The special meeting shall be convened by the speaker within 15 days at the request of the governor or at least one-third of the assembly members.

Plenary session

A plenary session will be held at the request of a quorum consisting of at least one-third of the assembly members. With the exception of cases stipulated by the Local Autonomy Act, agenda items can only pass on the condition that at least half of the members are present and at least half of those present vote to pass the item. In order to exercise the right to make a statement, an assembly member must acquire permission from the speaker in advance. The various types of statements encompass province-related questions, urgent issue-related questions, supplementary statements, clarification of personal matters, 5-minute free speeches, and contestation of a proceedings' progression.

Standing Committee

In order to review a wide range of agenda items efficiently in an expert-driven manner, the Jeollanam-do Provincial Assembly has 7 standing committees. During a regular session period, each standing committee will be held if there is a resolution to pass or a request from the speaker, the head of each committee, or at least one-third of the assembly members. During the closing period of a regular session, the Governor shall provide a document to the speaker or the head a of committee which that outlines reasons for the opening of a committee.

Special Committee

If necessary, a special committee is formed by plenary session vote and continued until a requested agenda is passed on at the plenary session. According to the ordinance, there are 2 permanent special committees: the Special committee on Budget and Accounting and the Special Committee on Ethics.

Through study and research, we conduct legislative activities to find answers in the field.




JEOLLANAMDO PROVINCIAL ASSEMBLY

The 12th Jeollanam-do Provincial Assembly enacts local ordinances for the development of Jeollanam-do and the happiness of its residents, and plays the role of a representative body to ensure reasonable administrative operation and transparent budget execution.









Enactment, amendment, and the repeal of ordinances

Ordinances, which can be called the laws of Jeollanam-do, may be enacted within the scope of laws and regulations, and enacted ordinances may be amended or repealed according to changes in circumstances. The purpose of the ordinance is to improve the quality of life by improving the welfare of the residents and to contribute to the sustainable development of Jeollanam-do.



Deliberation & confirmation of the budget and approval of accounting

The budget, which shows the amount of money Jeollanam-do spends throughout a year, is compiled by the governor and the superintendent of education and submitted to the parliament 50 days before the start of the fiscal year, and after a preliminary review by the competent Standing Committee and a comprehensive review by the Special Committee on Budget and Accounting, it is deliberated and finalized at the plenary session 15 days before the start of the fiscal year. The settlement of accounts is subject to approval in the following year after the provincial governor and superintendent of education execute the budget.



Acceptance and Handling of a Petition

Citizens can express their hopes or suggestions for improvement by submitting a document (petition) after being introduced by a member of the Provincial Assembly. However, we do not accept any content that interferes with the trial or violates laws and regulations. Petition is aThe Petition system system that can request relief from the Provincial Assembly and enforcement agencies when the rights or interests of residents are infringed upon, or demand correction of misconduct by public officials.



Administrative Audit and Inspection

There are administrative audits conducted annually for a period of not more than 14 days in relation to the overall affairs of Jeollanam-do and Jeollanam-do Office of Education and administrative investigations conducted by resolution of the plenary session on specific issues. The purpose of the administrative audit is to develop the Assembly by grasping the exact situation of its operation, requesting necessary corrections, and suggesting alternatives.



Autonomy

The Assembly has the authority to self-discipline without any involvement or interference from external agencies. Through powers such as Internal Organization Right (to choose the Speaker and set up Committees); Autonomy of Decision-making (to establish meeting rules, convene meetings, and make decisions); and the Right to Assess the Status of Members (capable of judging the disciplinary action of Members), the Assembly is fulfilling its role as a representative organization of the citizens.


